TRIP INFORMATION



- Date/Time:** Saturday, February 18, 2012 -- 8 a.m.
- Launch Site:** Burt Reynolds Park • Jupiter (Approx. 1/2 mile north of Indiantown Rd. on the east side of U.S. Highway 1, across from the Jupiter Chamber of Commerce.) Bigger boats with T-tops will need to use the ramps at the Chamber.
- Event Schedule:** Pick up official outing score sheets from Bill at the ramp at 8:00 a.m. or at the club prior to the outing -- Launch Boats and head up to Hobe Sound (or the Loxahatchee River if you prefer). Watch the manatee areas & no wake zone signs! Fish all morning until early afternoon. For those boats with radios, the official VHF channel will be 80. If you want to head to the Sound earlier, feel free to do so - just check in with Bill on VHF 80. 2:00 p.m. -- Head back to boat ramp • Burt Reynolds Park • Jupiter. This time may change if incimate weather occurs. All participants are encouraged to monitor VHF 80 during the outing to hear any special announcements. 3:00 p.m. -- Informal cookout and awards presentation at Burt Reynolds Park in an onsite pavilion to be announced. Bill will be coordinating the food for the outing - please plan to bring a side dish.
