Presented annually to the member scoring the most points for blue marlin releases in Bahamas (100 pts.) and Florida (300 pts.)

Jacob Lepera	12 Pacific sailfish (6 tagged) using 25 lb. tackle in Guatemala on March 2-4, 2 Pacific sailfish off of Costa Rica using 25 lb. tackle on Apr. 7-8, 2017. 3 dolphin & 3 blackfin tuna off Freeport, Bahamas using 50 lb. tackle on 5/11-12.
Mike Rendina	1 blue marlin on 50 lb. tackle & 1 white marlin on 30 lb. tackle both caught & released off Marsh Harbor on 4/21-22, 2017.
Laura Russell	2 blue marlin (on 5/20), 1 white marlin & 1 sailfish (on 5/4-5) all caught & released in Marsh Harbor, Bahamas using 30 lb. tackle. 3 blue marlin (up to 400 lbs.) in the Bahamas 6/9 - 6/17.
Michael Barry	3 white marlin & 1 blue marlin released off Marsh Harbor using 30 lb. tackle on 4/8 - 5/8, 2017.
Susan McCart	6 blue marlin, 3 sailfish & 1 white marlin all caught and released in the Bahamas using 30 lb. & 50 lb. tackle from 5/16 - 6/9, 2017.

The Richard Jeck Memorial Billfish Tagging Trophy

Presented annually to the member who tags the most billfish, including swordfish, off Florida & the Bahamas. Anglers must use approved Billfish Foundation or National Marine Fisheries Service tags. **Minimum of 20 fish must be tagged to win award.**
